



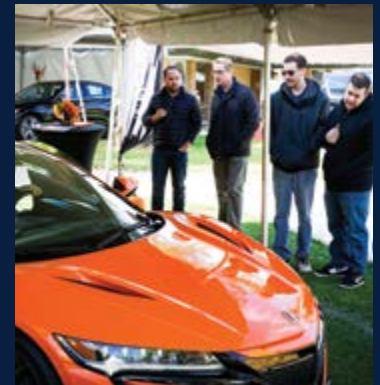

# ACCELERATE

## Technology Speeds Ahead at 55th Auto Show

Technology was front and center at the 2018 Northwood University International Auto Show (NUIAS). The students who planned and ran the Auto Show found many exciting ways to bring to campus the technological innovations that are accelerating the auto industry and shaping its future.

“Accelerate,” the theme of the 2018 NUIAS, revved the twin engines of progress in today’s automotive industry: speeding ahead of competition plus integrating cutting-edge technology in all aspects of automotive performance.

“One of the challenges we face in carrying on the show’s 55-year legacy is keeping it fresh and relevant each year. For 2018, we expanded the show by adding more teams and vehicles, and we received even more support from manufacturers,” said Ali Nasrallah, general chair of the NUIAS executive board. “Technology and innovation – such as virtual reality,

mobility, autonomous cars, and vehicle-to-vehicle communication – are propelling the industry faster than ever. So we featured these advancements throughout the show in obvious and subtle ways.”

NU Tech, a new addition to the show, demonstrated how computer applications have become integral to connecting dealerships with their customers. The technology of NU Tech helped visitors learn about vehicles in a new way. Team members accessed information instantly and were able to send it to any phone or email address using a program donated by MAXDigital, a software

and mobile applications developer for the automotive industry. Other examples of technology featured at the show included Tesla, Inc., a first-time participant; several interactive programs that engaged guests; and a distracted driver computer simulation. NU Tech's success validates the NUIAS executive board's five-year plan to implement it fully into future auto shows.

Another success of NUIAS, the largest outdoor auto show in North America, was the growth of the Aftermarket division. This year it expanded to include 31 exhibitors from a wider variety of specialties. Visitors saw more vehicles of all types, including a Polaris Slingshot® three-wheel motorcycle, in the exhibits. Seeing the numerous possibilities to upgrade and personalize vehicles fueled renewed interest in this section of the show.

“Accelerate” also reflected the way experiential learning helps advance students’ educations and future careers. More than 500 students from all curriculums participated in a variety of ways, including planning and logistics, marketing and advertising, booth design and visitor interaction, and hospitality and fashion.

“Working on the Auto Show is demanding and a lot of fun, but also extremely valuable. What’s amazing is the way employers view show participation,” said Nasrallah. “They are not just looking at experience. They also look for progression of skills and ability to collaborate. The Auto Show is an opportunity to gain all of that and more.”

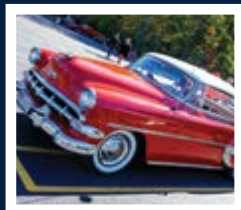

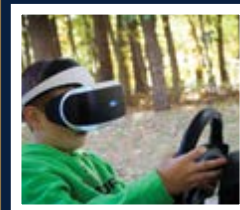

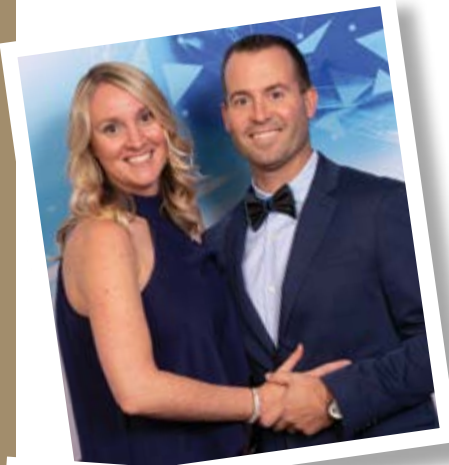

# On the Rise

## Three Grads Make Automotive News List of 40 Under 40

Years of sustained success by many Northwood graduates have established the University as one of the best places to begin a career in automotive marketing. Now, that reputation is being reinforced by a new generation of young leaders. • When Automotive News released its latest list of 40 outstanding industry leaders below the age of 40, three Northwood grads were among them. • All three – **Mark Foster ('04)**, **Jesse Peterson ('02)**, and **Larry Zinn ('08)** – were advised by friends to attend Northwood. And all three say it was great advice.

“Going to Northwood was one of the best decisions I ever made,” Zinn said. “Northwood had a profound impact on me. I don’t think I would be where I am today, or have the success I have been fortunate enough to have in my young career, if I hadn’t gone to Northwood.”

At 32, Zinn is general manager of the Warren Henry Auto Group in Florida, overseeing nine dealerships at six different locations around the state. He grew up in Miami, spending much of his free time hanging out at his father’s dealership. But when it was time to pick a college, Zinn wasn’t sure he wanted to go into the family business, so he headed off to a big East Coast research university.

*“The classes at my previous college were very large and I did not get to spend time with my professors. I never felt connected to anything,” Zinn recalled. “My father and uncle were both Northwood grads. I was a little reluctant because transferring to Northwood would be such a stark change, but the classes were smaller and I got a lot more personal attention. I felt like I was part of a community.”*

Zinn thrived in Midland, graduating just as the 2008 recession was impacting the auto retailing industry. He stepped into a role in his father’s business and immediately got creative. With most automakers and banks unable to provide financing to buyers, Zinn led a drive to convert customers from all the businesses’ dealerships into buyers of the one nameplate that was still able to offer loans. Sales soared, providing a jump-start to Zinn’s career.

Jesse Peterson also credits Northwood for getting his career off to a good start.

*“The curriculum at Northwood is great, but the connections are what really make the difference,” said Peterson, 38, who is now president of three dealerships centered in Bismarck, North Dakota. “I loved the four years I spent there.”*

Though his grandfather and father both owned dealerships, Peterson’s first job after graduating was with American Honda, allowing him to gain insight from the manufacturer’s side. Eventually, he went to work at his grandfather’s dealership in 2005, and he’s been there ever since.

“Bismarck is a beautiful, beautiful area. It’s a city of about 120,000 people, a lot like Midland in many ways. I love it here,” Peterson said. “My business partners and I would like to acquire some more stores. We’re always looking for opportunities.”

Unlike the other two honorees, Mark Foster, 36, didn’t have a relative in the business, but he did have a strong interest in cars. Two days after his high school graduation, Foster started working for his hometown dealership in Carrollton, Georgia, an hour west of Atlanta. The dealership’s general manager suggested Northwood, and Foster is glad he did. As domestic chair and vice chair of the Northwood Auto Show, Foster learned leadership skills that still serve him well.

*“Learning how to convince your classmates to respect you enough to work for you and create a product that the locals enjoyed when they came to the NU Auto Show, that was valuable,” Foster said.*

Foster also understands how to serve customers, and has been quick to adapt to their desire to do business online.

“The American culture has embraced a new thought process. Who has what I want, is it priced competitively, do they answer my phone call or email when I call them? And if you can answer yes to all three, you just sold them a car,” Foster explained. “It’s been very interesting to see how that thought process has changed every aspect of daily operations, from scheduling service visits to ordering parts to buying vehicles.”

The hometown dealership where Foster started has seen its sales double with him as executive manager. He’s been so successful that he and a partner bought the dealership this fall.

## German Native Turns NU Degree into a Springboard to the Big Time

People sell cars differently in Germany than they do in the United States.

Johannes Gnauck recognized some of those differences soon after arriving in Florida in 2005 to complete his Bachelor's degree at Northwood's campus there. He understood the differences more fully when he returned to his native land to begin his sales career at a German dealership. And he capitalized on that understanding in 2012 when he and a partner launched a start-up company that uses big data technology to boost vehicle sales.

That company, automotiveMastermind, was ranked by Inc. magazine as the seventh-fastest-growing company in America in 2017, and the second-fastest-growing software company. The company's clients include more than 1,300 dealerships across the country. Income in 2016 was \$23 million.

Gnauck doesn't claim Germans do it better. He doesn't claim Americans do it better. And he doesn't claim computers do it better. But it seems that combining the strengths of all three, along with a healthy dose of ingenuity, can produce outstanding results.

"What I decided to do was take a step back. Think outside of the box. Understand what the sales process was all about," Gnauck explained. "While the vehicles might be engineered in a very sophisticated way, the sales process isn't. You could walk into 350 dealerships, and every single one will have a different sales process."

Gnauck's quest to understand that process began back in his college days. After earning his Bachelor of Business Administration in Automotive Marketing and Management at Northwood, he spent several years working in sales for Mercedes-Benz in Stuttgart, Germany.

"I decided to take the toolkit I had and become a master of selling cars," he said. "Selling cars is actually a career in Germany. You don't just walk in off the street and start selling cars like they do in the U.S. They take it a bit more seriously over there. You have to get certification. You've got to study law and finance and taxation."

Looking to expand his advancement opportunities, Gnauck applied for a job at the company's American flagship dealership in New York, striking up a relationship with the sales manager, Marco Schnabl, also a native of Germany. Among their many common interests was a fascination with the sales process, as well as a thirst for developing ways to improve it.

"I was inspired by the passion and the culture and the entrepreneurial spirit in the U.S.," Gnauck said. "People in the U.S. are more risk-takers by nature. Sometimes I think people here want to fail, and they want to fail as quickly as possible so they can learn from it. With that kind of attitude, you always are set up for success."

Another thing Gnauck observed was that automotive salespeople had access to an increasingly massive pool of data about potential buyers, but they had neither the time to gather it all nor the expertise to interpret it. So Gnauck and Schnabl decided to do it for them, developing a sophisticated algorithm that produces information that helps automotiveMastermind's clients sell more effectively.

"Marco and I run the company as co-CEOs. I lead our product, engineering, and data science teams; Marco focuses on the commercial and business side – a big part is focused on helping our dealer partners to fully leverage the platform," Gnauck said. "A year and a half

ago, we had 70 employees. One year later, we had 250 employees. We are in a hyper-growth stage. It's a great problem to have, but it's not easy."

The success of automotiveMastermind led to the company being acquired in 2017 by IHS Markit, a Britain-based company whose holdings include CarFax and the Jane's family of military information publishers. Now, automotiveMastermind is a subsidiary of a global enterprise with \$21 billion in market capitalization.

"It was kind of a too-good-to-be-true, strategic market fit," Gnauck said.

"Our behavior prediction technology will be exponentially richer by leveraging the wealth of IHS Markit data assets."

## Here's How it Works

The products offered by automotiveMastermind are based on a proprietary algorithm that uses more than 1,000 data points to generate a ranking between 1 and 100 for each potential customer. The higher the ranking, the more likely that customer is to buy a vehicle soon. It also forecasts what will motivate each customer, which helps salespeople to steer their efforts in productive directions. Clients who use the technology report average advertising costs per sale of \$128, compared to an industry average of \$632.

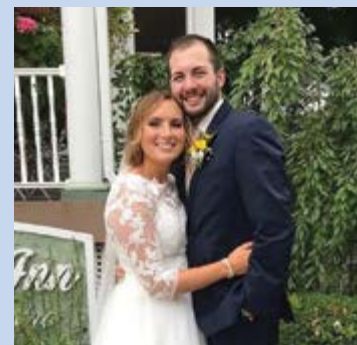

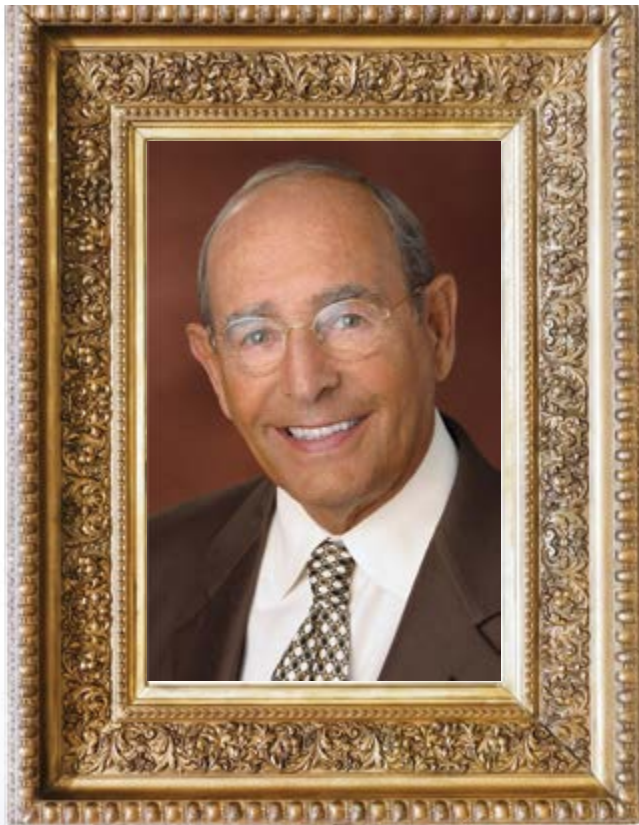

## Northwood Mourns Passing of Richard DeVos



An existential force in the development of Northwood University was lost this fall when Richard DeVos, 92, died Sept. 6 at his home in Ada, Michigan.

DeVos was the co-founder of Amway, co-owner of the Orlando Magic professional basketball franchise, and namesake of Northwood's Richard DeVos Graduate School of Management Building.

*"His success and his generosity will have a fundamental impact on our University for many, many years," said Northwood President and CEO Dr. Keith Pretty.*

In 1994, a grant from the Richard and Helen DeVos Foundation allowed Northwood to establish The DeVos Graduate School of Management. DeVos said he made the gift "to perpetuate the education

of business leaders with an understanding of democratic and compassionate capitalism and because Northwood University is the school with the most distinguished record of helping people learn to start and to own their own business."

His wife, Helen DeVos, died in 2017. They leave four children, including Daniel G. DeVos, a member of the Northwood Board of Trustees, and Dick DeVos, whose wife, Betsy, is the United States Secretary of Education.

DeVos and his high school friend Jay Van Andel co-founded Amway in 1959, working at first in a basement and later at a converted gas station. By 1980 the privately held company was a billion-dollar enterprise, selling a range of household products through a network of commission-incentivized distributors.

*"We call our company Amway," DeVos said, "because the American way of private ownership and free enterprise is the best way."*

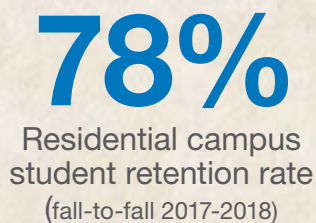
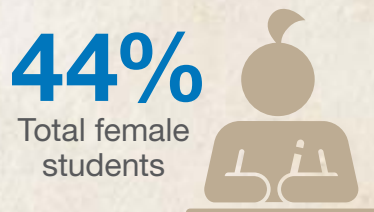
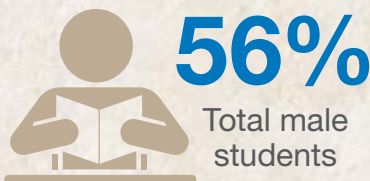

# Students Test Drive the Tech Side of Auto Industry

Now that he's got the No. 2 job at a growing tech company supporting U.S. auto dealers, Mike Cavanaugh has a simple message for the students at his alma mater:

## **opportunity is calling.**

Cavanaugh ('07, '11) is executive vice president of MAXDigital, which provides cloud-based software and mobile applications to the automotive industry. Its products include FirstLook, an inventory management platform, MAX for Website, a vehicle value and content creator for dealer websites, and MAX Digital Showroom, a real-time sales tool for desktop and mobile.

Thanks to arrangements made by Cavanaugh, more than 70 students used Digital Showroom on their phones and tablets to become "instant product experts" at this year's Northwood International Auto Show.

"It allowed my team to be very versatile, especially when team members needed to switch from a Corvette to a Traverse in a moment's notice," said Brooklyn Nelson, a Northwood junior and team captain for the show. "It was also a great confidence booster. It served as an aid for those who didn't have a high level of knowledge about the Chevrolet lineup and definitely gave them confidence to get out and interact with show-goers all weekend."

MAXDigital, based in Chicago, has about 100 employees and is adding more positions quickly. Part of Cavanaugh's intent for the Auto Show was to broaden students' vision of potential careers in the auto industry.

*"Traditionally, the career opportunities are in original equipment manufacturers or dealerships, but there are all these cool things that they can go into, and if you want to go into tech and stay in the auto industry, there are many ways to go," Cavanaugh said. "With the entrepreneurial mindset that Northwood instills in students, it can be a really good fit."*

The opportunities extend well beyond programmers and software engineers, Cavanaugh said.

"When you go into a new product line, you've got to scale up your ranks dramatically – on the account manager side, on the support side – there are so many opportunities that come with it," he said. "And we're not the only ones. There are a lot of cool companies out there. Chicago is the tech hub of the Midwest."
